The Friends plan to develop specific projects that advance their mission. They will also have regular meetings, social events, and cultural field trips.

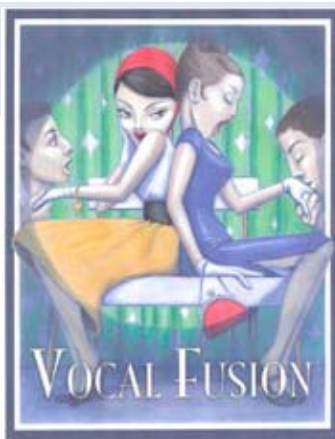

Enjoy the incredible voices of young stars of the Orlando Opera Sunday afternoon, April 26th. The opera company will perform a program called Vocal Fusion. This is the third year Lake Eustis Institute has brought the opera to Eustis. The performance will be at The Woman's Club of Eustis, 227 N. Center St. at 3:00 PM. Tea will be served by The Woman's Club during intermission.

Vocal Fusion is presented in the style of a 1950's television variety show, a tribute to The Bell Telephone Hour and The Ed Sullivan show, Vocal Fusion combines the best of opera and musical theater. This original, two act program shows off the vocal agility of the Orlando Opera studio artists.



This year, a number of Broadway and opera songs will be performed: popular songs from Kiss Me Kate, Guys and Dolls, and My Fair Lady and beloved arias such as "La fleur que tu m'avais jetée," (Carmen by Georges Bizet), "Aprite un po' quegli occhi" (The Marriage of Figaro by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart), and "Mira, o Norma," (Norma

by Vincenzo Bellini).
